The American Revolution | Theatre Unspeakable



Using only the actor's bodies, voices and (pantomimed) cannons, the show evokes an epic time period in American history. Combining tongue-in-cheek humor with a dash of derring-do, *The American Revolution* displays Theater Unspeakable's rowdy brand of bare-boned and imaginative physical theater. Best for Grades 5+.




A Very Electric Christmas | Lightwire Theater


